Vision for the school

- To challenge every student to raise their aspirations and excel in both academic achievement and in developing vocational skill sets
- To nurture and develop in students the values and characteristics necessary to become successful, confident and responsible members of society—so that parents will say
- To teach students the value of self-discipline, resilience and respect in order to become life long learners with the positive attitudes required by employers now and in the future

Our education offer

The proposed new Ladder School is a specialist alternative provision school providing education for 112 students aged 13-18.

Due to open in January 2019.

The School will enable students to return to their mainstream setting and/or leave the school with the same academic currency as any other student attending a mainstream school.

The school will cater for primarily the needs of Walsall students with the potential to serve the wider Black Country

All students are expected to leave the School having completed GCSE's in Maths and English and at least 3 other qualifications.
